## PRACTICE DIRECTION

Re: Procedure in Appeals to the Caribbean Court of Justice and The Caribbean Court of Justice (Appellate Jurisdiction)(Amendment) Rules, 2008

The Chief Justice issues the following Practice Direction:

- 1. On 1 April 2008 the Caribbean Court of Justice made The Caribbean Court of Justice (Appellate Jurisdiction)(Amendment) Rules, 2008 (hereinafter called "The Rules". These Rules came into force on the said date. They amend The Caribbean Court of Justice (Appellate Jurisdiction) Rules, 2005, specifically Parts 10 and 13 thereof. In addition, the Third Schedule to The Rules sets out:
  - (a) Tables of fees payable to the Court and fees payable to a party in an appeal from the Court of Appeal of Barbados; and
  - (b) various Forms for use on appeal.
- 2. The Rules of 2008 were published in the Official Gazette of Barbados on 8 January 2009 and apply to Barbados with effect from this said date.
- 3. Thus, in future, all appeals from the Court of Appeal of Barbados to the Caribbean Court of Justice must, with effect from 8 January 2009, comply with The Caribbean Court of Justice (Appellate Jurisdiction) Rules, 2005 as amended by The Rules of 2008.
- 4. Practice Direction No.1/2005 (dated 7 July 2005) is hereby revoked.
