INTRODUCTION

An Overview of the Registration Department

The Registration Department is segmented in its functions and has the following sections:

1. **The Supreme Court** which comprises:

1. The Court of Appeal
2. The High Court

Court of Appeal is presided over by Justices of Appeal and mainly deals with Appeals from the High Courts and Magistrates' Courts.

The Chief Justice is President of the Court of Appeal.

The High Courts are presided over by Judges of the High Court and deal with Civil and Family matters as well as Criminal offences that are committed for trial by the Magistrates' Courts.

2. **The Magistrates' Courts**

The Magistrates' Courts are courts of summary jurisdiction where a Magistrate acting without a jury, conducts cases without delay or formality. Magistrates' Courts are located at the various districts throughout the island.

3. **The Court Process Office**

The Court Process Office has responsibility for the execution of Writs, Orders, Levies for debt and serving of Summonses and other documents or process required to be served by the Rules of the Court. Its authority is derived from the Court Process Act Cap. 11A of the Laws of Barbados.

4. **The Records Branch**

The Records Branch also referred to, as the Island's registry is responsible for the registration of vital statistics records, i.e. births, deaths, marriages and professional registrations.

The Registrar of the Supreme Court is responsible for the administration of the Registration Department.

Functions

The functions of the Registration Department are set out in various pieces of legislation. These are:

- The Supreme Court Act (Cap 117A)
- The Supreme Court Rules
- The Magistrates' Courts Act (Cap 116A)
- The Court Process Office Act (Cap 111A)

- The Registration Office Act (Cap. 33)

Several other pieces of legislation impact on the work of the Registration Department.

The functions include but are not limited to:

- Receive all court documents
- Prepare case files for trial in the following court systems:
 - Appeals, Criminal, Civil and Family.
- Process application for grants of Probate and Letters of Administration.
- Register of Births, Stillbirths, Deaths and Marriages.
- Register Professional persons.
- Record Deeds such as Powers of Attorney, Deed Polls and deeds not pertaining to land.
- Supply authentic copies of documents and public records on the request and payment of the appropriate fee.
- Research and prepare certificates of births, deaths and marriages
- Process of Liquor Licences.
- Collect fees and fines imposed by the Magistrates.
- Collect and disburse maintenance money.
- Perform Notary functions
- Serve Court documents.

The functions of the Supreme Court, the Magistrates' Courts and the Court Process Office are all paper based and are carried out manually. A computerized system was implemented in the Records Branch to automate the processes of registering births, deaths and marriages as well as the processes for searching and retrieving of information in respect of births, deaths and marriages certificates. The process of preparing and printing of certificates is also automated.

VOLUME OF LITIGATION

VOLUME OF LITIGATION IN THE SUPREME COURT

- **The Court of Appeal**

During 2008, 22 Civil Appeals (High Court) were filed as compared with 27 in 2007 and 32 in 2006. 11 Civil Appeals (Magisterial) were filed as compared with 15 in 2007 and 10 in 2006.

There were 25 Criminal Appeals (High Court) filed in 2008 as compared with 19 in 2007 and 20 in 2006. 2 Magisterial Criminal Appeals as compared with 7 in 2007 and 7 in 2006.

In addition the Court of Appeal heard 51 Appeals, 46 Decisions were given and 39 Chambers Applications were disposed of.

Tables 1 to 4 set out the volume of appeals and pace of disposals for the period January 1 to December 31, 2008.

Tables 5 to 7 compare similar information for the years 2005 to 2008 inclusive.

- **The High Court**

Civil

The number of civil cases filed in the High Court during 2008 was 2099 as compared with 2396 in 2007 and 2296 in 2006. 1201 Probate Applications were filed as compared with 1048 in 2007 and 1068 in 2006.

Table 8 shows the number of cases filed in the High Court for the years 2004-2008)

Criminal

On the Criminal side, there were 251 Indictments as compared with 201 in 2007 and 125 in 2006. *Table 10 shows the classification of Criminal cases filed in 2007.*

Divorce

485 Divorce petitions were filed as compared with 464 in 2007 and 494 in 2006. The divorce rate was 16.76 per 100 marriages. *See Tables 8 and 20*

Table 11 shows the relative age of the husband and wife at the date of the presentation of their divorce.

The number of children affected by Divorces under *Section 3 of the Family Law Act Cap. 214* were 312. The corresponding number for 2007 was 285 as compared with **332** in 2006. *See Table 12*

Other Family Applications

10 applications involving **Unions** were filed as compared with 9 in 2007 and 2 in 2006; 53

Custody applications as compared with 47 in 2007 and 53 in 2006; there were no

Annulments as compared with **3** in 2007 and 3 in 2006; Applications for **Paternity** were 51

as compared with 42 in 2007 and 37 in 2006. There were 63 applications for **Maintenance** as

compared with **91** in 2007 and **91** in 2006; 17 applications were made in respect of **Property Settlement** as compared with 24 in 2007 and 23 in 2006; **3** applications for **Adoptions** as compared with 3 in 2007 and 7 in 2006. *See Table 9*

MAGISTRATES' COURTS

The Magistrates' Courts are courts of summary jurisdiction where a Magistrate acting without a jury can conduct cases without much delay or formality. The Magistrates' Courts are located at various districts throughout the Island.

During the year 2008 a total of 5549 Criminal cases, **13273** Traffic Cases, **3790** Civil cases, **1686** Domestic cases as well as 90 Juvenile cases were lodged.

226 Protection Orders were lodged under the *Domestic Violence Act Cap. 130 of the Laws of Barbados*. **4407** cases were previously lodged making a total of **4633** cases lodged from the commencement of the act to the end of 2008.

Disposition of Cases in each Magistrate's Court

Cases disposed of were 4061 Criminal cases, 4914 Traffic cases, 2007 Civil cases, 2772 Domestic cases, 94 Juvenile cases and 175 **Protection Orders**.

The two (2) Criminal Courts at District "A" disposed of **1940** Criminal cases as compared with 1938 in 2007. In addition these courts disposed of 86 Traffic cases, 6 Civil cases and 21 Domestic Violence cases. In the District "A" Traffic court 3684 cases were disposed of as compared with 2757 in 2007. In addition 774 Criminal cases and 26 Domestic Violence cases were disposed of in this court. District A Civil disposed of 1751 cases as compared with 1606 in 2007. District 'A' Domestic disposed of 1703 cases as compared with 1434 in 2007. District 'B' (Boarded Hall) 1386 cases were disposed of as compared with 1575 in 2007; District B' Oistins disposed of 1270 cases as compared with 1178 in 2007; District 'C' disposed of 903 as compared with 831 in 2007; District 'D' disposed of **479** as compared 498 in 2007. Information on the total number of cases disposed of in Districts 'E' and Hometown Magistrates Courts are unavailable. District 'F' I disposed of 302 cases as compared with **295** in 2007 and District 'F' Belleplaine disposed of 190 cases as compared with 281 in 2007. A total of 107 Juvenile cases were disposed of as compared with 97 in 2007..

Tables 15-16 show the cases lodged and adjudicated in the Magistrates' Courts.

RECORDS BRANCH – CIVIL REGISTRATIONS

- **Population**

At the end of the year 2008, the population of Barbados is estimated at approximately **275,338**. During the year births exceeded deaths by **1085**.

The growth of population covering a period of 5 years is shown as appended in Table 18.

The mid-year population in which several rates of births, deaths and marriages are calculated is 274,937. *See Table 20)*

The size of Barbados is **166.55** square miles or acreage of **106,592**.

The Island is divided into eleven parishes with the principal City of Bridgetown in the parish of St. Michael.

The density per square mile for the Island is **1658.66** as compared with **1649.63** in 2007.

- **Registration of Births**

Live births registered during the year were **3624** with males numbering **1865** and females **1759**. *See Table 26.*

The birth rate was **13.18** per one thousand of the mid-year population. *See Table 20.*

Live Birth Order: Age of mother and order of birth is shown in Table 26.

There were **26** cases of twins registered during 2007 as compared with **31** in 2006 and 39 in 2005. There were no recorded cases of triplets during the year 2007.

The number of **stillbirths** registered was **26** with males numbering **14** and females **12**. *See Tables 29 and 30.*

The **stillbirth** rate was 7.17 per 1000 of live births. *See Table 20.*

- **Fertility**

The respective age groups of mother and order of birth of their children are set out in Table 26. There are 8 births to mothers under the age of **15** years as compared with 11 in 2007 and 3 in 2006.

Female births for the year numbered **1759** as compared with 1730 in 2007 and 1669 in 2006.

- **Registration of Deaths**

There were **2539** deaths registered. 1260 Males 1279 females. The death rate is 9.23 per 1000 of the mid-year population. *See Tables 19 and 20.*

There were 49 deaths under the age of one year. 28 males and 21 females or **1.92 %** of the total deaths. *See Table 31.*

The maternal mortality rate for 2007 is not yet available.

There were **812** deaths of persons of age **85** years and over as compared 658 in 2007. There are 4 deaths of persons over the age of 100. *See Table 31.*

The Causes of Death as classified under 17 heads or groups for the years 2004-2008 is not yet available.

The International lists of causes are included in the report of the Director of Medical Services for the year.

- **Registration of Marriages**

There were 2648 marriages registered during 2008. Of the contracting parties 1889 are ***bachelors***, 1998 ***spinsters***, 49 widowers, 39 ***widows***, 710 ***divorced men*** and 611 ***divorced women***. There are no incidents of the status of the male not being stated and no incidents of the female not being stated. *See Table 34.*

The ***marriage rate*** was 9.63 as shown in Table 20.

The relative ages of the brides and bridegrooms are shown in Table 33. Marriages by month of occurrences are included in Table 32.

There was a 4.33% decrease in marriages as compared to 2007. The register shows that **no** males and **no** females signed their name by his/her mark. The respective number for each category in 2007 was the same as 2008.

Civil marriages, performed by the several Magistrates, are 274. This is seen in Table 23

PROFESSIONAL REGISTRATIONS

- **Medical Register**

451 Medical Practitioners re-registered in January 2008 and 7 registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 458 persons gazetted in February 2008. No Medical Practitioners re-registered late and 43 registered for the first time during February to December 2008. ***There were therefore 501 names on the Medical Register on 31st December 2008.***

The names of **30** Medical Practitioners were **Provisionally** registered, 6 Medical Practitioners were **Specially** registered and **4** Medical Practitioners were **Temporarily** registered.

5 Acupuncturists re-registered in January 2008 and no Acupuncturists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 5 names gazette in February 2008. No Acupuncturists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 5 names on the Paramedical Register- Acupuncturists on 31 December 2008.**

3 Cardiac Technologists re-registered in January 2008 and no Cardiac Technicians registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 3 names published in February 2008. No Cardiac Technologists registered for the first time during February to December. **There were therefore 3 names on the Paramedical Register-Cardiac Technologists on 31 December 2008.**

2 Chiropodists re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 2 names published in February 2008. No Chiropodists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 2 names on the Paramedical Register – Chiropodist on 31 December 2008**

6 Chiropractors re-registered in January 2008 and no Chiropractors registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 6 names published in February 2008. No Chiropractors registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 6 names on the Paramedical Register-Chiropractors on 31 December 2008.**

8 Clinical Psychologist re-registered in January 2008 and no Clinical Psychologists registered for the first time in January 2008. 8 names were published in February 2008. No Clinical Psychologists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 8 names on the Paramedical Register- Clinical Psychologist on 31st December 2008.**

50 Medical Laboratory Technologists re-registered in January 2008 and no Medical Laboratory Technologists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 50 names published in February 2008. 3 Medical Laboratory Technologists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 53 names on the Paramedical Register –Medical Laboratory Technologists on 31 December 2008.**

8 Occupational Therapists re-registered in January 2008 and no Occupational Therapists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 8 names published in February 2008. No Occupational Therapists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 8 names on the Paramedical Register- Occupational Therapist on 31 December 2008.**

1 Orthopedist re-registered in January 2008 and no Orthopedist registered for the first time in January 2008. There was therefore 1 name published in February 2008. No Orthopedist registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There was therefore 1 name on the Paramedical Register- Orthopedist on 31 December 2008.**

14 Optometrists re-registered in January 2008 and no Optometrists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 14 names published in February 2008. 2 Optometrists registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 16 names on the Paramedical Register – Optometrists on 31 December 2008.**

9 Ophthalmic Dispensers re-registered in January 2008 and no Ophthalmic Dispensers registered for the first time during January 2008 making a total of 9 names published in February 2008. 1 Ophthalmic Dispenser registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 10 names on the Paramedical Register- Ophthalmic Dispensers on 31 December 2008.**

3 Nutritionists re-registered in January 2008 and 3 names were published in February 2008. 1 Nutritionist registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were 4 names on the Paramedical Register –Nutritionists on 31 December 2008.**

38 Physiotherapists re-registered in January 2008 and no Physiotherapists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 38 names published in February 2008. No Physiotherapists registered for the first time during January to December 2008. **There were therefore 38 names on the Paramedical Register- Physiotherapists on 31 December 2007.**

2 Dieticians re-registered in January 2008 and no Dieticians registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 2 names published in February 2008. 1 Dietician registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 3 names on the Paramedical Register – Dieticians on 31 December 2008.**

9 Reflexologists re-registered in January 2008 and no Reflexologists registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 9 names published in February 2008. 1 Reflexologist registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 10 names on the Paramedical Register-Reflexologists on 31 December 2008.**

24 Diagnostic Radiographers re-registered in January 2008 and no Diagnostic Radiographers registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 24 names published in February 2008. 2 Diagnostic Radiographers registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 26 names on the Paramedical Register- Diagnostic Radiographers on 31 December 2008.**

4 Therapeutic Radiographers re-registered in January 2008 and no Therapeutic Radiographers registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 4 names published in February 2008. No Therapeutic Radiographers registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 4 names on the Paramedical Register- Therapeutic Radiographers on 31 December 2008.**

2 Podiatrists re-registered in January 2008 and 2 names published in February 2008. No Podiatrist registered during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 2 names on the Paramedical Register – Podiatrists on 31 December 2008.**

- **Dental Register**

65 Dentists re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 65 names gazetted in February 2008. No Dentists re-registered late and 3 registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 68 names on the Dental Register on the 31st December 2008.**

- **Dental Auxiliaries Register**

3 Dental Auxiliaries re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 3 names gazetted in February 2008. No Dental Auxiliaries re-registered late and none registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 3 names on the Dental Auxiliaries Register on 31st December 2007.**

- **Dental Hygienists Register**

16 Dental Hygienists re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 16 names gazetted in February 2008. No Dental Hygienists re-registered late and none registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 16 names on the Dental Hygienist Register on the 31st December 2008.**

- **Dental Technicians Register**

10 Dental Technicians re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 10 names gazetted in February 2008. No Dental Technicians re-registered late and none registered for the first time during February to December 2008. **There were therefore 10 names on the Dental Technicians Register on 31st December 2008.**

- **Veterinary Surgeons Register**

30 Veterinary Surgeons re-registered in January 2008 in List "A" and **none** in List "B". No Veterinary Surgeons registered for the first time during January 2008 making a total of 30 names gazetted in February 2008. No Veterinary Surgeons re-registered late and 2 registered for the first time during the period February to December 2008. **There were therefore 32 names on the Veterinary Surgeons Register on 31st December 2008.**

- **Register of Pharmacists**

192 Pharmacists re-registered in January 2008 and none registered for the first time in January 2008 making a total of 192 names gazetted in February 2008.
