PUBLIC NOTICE

The Supreme Court embarked on a "Backlog Reduction Project" which commenced on 1st February 2013.

The Project will at the outset address Civil cases filed in the High Court between 1 January, 1990 and 30 September, 2009.

A Practice Direction No. 1/2013 has been issued by the Chief Justice on the Backlog Reduction Project which includes directions on the Status Hearings and Forms for the use in the Process.

For this purpose a "Backlog Case", as defined in paragraph 1.2 of the Practice Direction, means "a High Court Civil action filed under the Rules of the Supreme Court 1982 within the period 1 January, 1990 and 30 September, 2009 and which remains undetermined".

ALL persons with Backlog Cases are hereby requested to inspect the Annual Lists of Backlog Cases on the Court's website and to contact their attorneys-at-law concerning the status of their cases.

Persons with Backlog Cases and their attorneys-at-law will shortly receive a Notice from the Registrar seeking information on the status of those cases.
