ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the *Pensions (Miscellaneous* Short title *Provisions) Act*, 2011.
- 2. The Act set out in paragraph 1 under Column 1 of the *Schedule* Amendment is amended in the manner specified opposite thereto in Column 2 of that of Cap. 25 Schedule.
