**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2011*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday, September 3, 2011

- (a) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter, the section of road known as Oxford Road, commencing from the junction with Luke Hill (Charles Duncan O'Neal Highway), proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Oxford Road, continuing in an easterly direction on Mount Gay Road, proceeding in an easterly direction on Alexandra Road and finishing at the junction of Collins and Date Tree Hill.
- (b) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Belleplaine Road commencing from the junction with Isolation Road, proceeding in a southerly direction along the said Belleplaine Road, continuing in a southerly direction on Haggatts, Bruce Vale, Baxters, Cane Garden and Spring Vale Roads and finishing at the junction of Chapman Village and Sturges Roads.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
