**TRAFFIC CONTROL (INDEPENDENCE ANNIVERSARY
PARADE AND MARCH) RULES, 2011**

The Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Independence Anniversary Parade and March) Rules, 2011*.

2. In these Rules,

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Department of Emergency Management; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

“identification mark” means any badge, label or mark issued by the Commissioner or by his authority that is affixed to or displayed on the front of any vehicle on the relevant date;

“relevant date” means Wednesday, 30th November, 2011;

“route” means Garrison Hill Road, Bay Street, Chamberlain Bridge, National Heroes Square, Trafalgar Street, Bridge Street, Charles Duncan O’Neal Bridge, Lower Fairchild Street and Independence Square in the parish of Saint Michael;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*. Cap. 295.

3. On the relevant date, the Independence Anniversary Parade and March will take place at the Garrison Savannah in the parish of Saint Michael and along the route.

4. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 11:00 hours, drivers and riders of vehicles using the Garrison Hill Road shall proceed in one direction only and shall keep the Garrison Savannah on their right.

5. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 11:00 hours, no driver, or other person in charge of a vehicle shall park or allow the vehicle to remain stationary on the route, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

6. All drivers of vehicles conveying persons to the Garrison Savannah shall enter the Garrison Savannah as follows:

- (a) drivers of vehicles bearing the identification mark "Y" in black on a white background, in the area in front of the Savannah Club, (excluding the area near the cannons);
- (b) drivers of vehicles bearing the identification mark "E" in black on a white background, in the area of the betting booth at the Garrison Savannah;
- (c) drivers of vehicles bearing the identification mark "LP" in black on a white background, in the car park of the Barbados Light & Power Company Limited;
- (d) drivers of vehicles bearing the identification mark "GWH" in black on a pink background, in the car park of the George Washington House; and
- (e) drivers of vehicles bearing the identification mark "SH" in black on a yellow background, on the compound of the Savannah Hotel

and shall park as directed by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

7. Drivers or riders of vehicles shall comply with these Rules and with any direction given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

8. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 6 months.

9. Rule 4 shall not apply to a motor omnibus, route taxi or minibus plying its route.

10. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or to any emergency vehicle.
