NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY (BENEFITS) ORDER, 2011

The National Insurance Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 25A of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security (Benefits) Order*, 2011.
- 2. With effect from 2nd January, 2012, the amount to be paid weekly as
 - (a) old age contributory pension; and
 - (b) invalidity pension

shall be not less than \$170 per week.

- 3. With effect from 2nd January, 2012, an insured person who on or before 31st December, 2011 had been entitled to
 - (a) an old age contributory pension;
 - (b) a survivor's pension;
 - (c) a death benefit; or
 - (d) an invalidity pension

shall be paid an additional amount of 4.01 per cent of the pension benefit to which that person had been entitled on 31st December, 2011.

- 4. With effect from 1st January, 2012,
- (a) a funeral grant shall be an amount of \$1,890; and
- (b) a maternity grant shall be an amount of \$1,090.

S.I. 2010 5. The National Insurance and Social Security (Benefit) No. 150. (No. 2) Order, 2010 is revoked.
