DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2011.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, March 13, 2011

- (a) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint George, the section of road known as Ellesmere commencing from the junction with Prerogative Road, proceeding in an easterly and north-easterly direction on the said Ellesmere Road, continuing in a southerly direction on Todds and Woodland Roads and finishing at the junction with the Woodland Triangle.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
