**CIVIL AVIATION (AIRWORTHINESS)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2011**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 10 of the *Civil Aviation Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Civil Aviation (Airworthiness) (Amendment) Regulations, 2011*.

2. The *Civil Aviation (Airworthiness) Regulations, 2007*, are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 32 the following: S.I. 2007  
No. 175.

“Weighing  
of aircraft      **32A.(1)** An operator shall, in respect of an aircraft, request a certificate from the manufacturer of the aircraft that verifies that the manufacturer, on completing the manufacture of the aircraft, weighed the aircraft to determine the basic weight of the aircraft and the corresponding centre of gravity of the aircraft.

(2) Where an inspector requests the certificate from the operator, the operator shall produce the certificate to the inspector.

(3) The operator shall ensure that the aircraft is weighed at the periods stipulated by the Airworthiness Standards.

(4) Subject to paragraph (3), the operator shall document the weight of the aircraft as specified in the Airworthiness Standards."
