DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2011.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, April 17, 2011

- (a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint George, the section of road known as Wilson Hill, proceeding in a northerly direction to the junction at Easy Hall, continuing in an easterly direction pass Malvern and Venture, proceeding in an easterly direction to the junction at Hothersal and Clifton Hall.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
