**POST OFFICE (POSTAGE PAID) (AMENDMENT)**  
**REGULATIONS, 2011**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 59 of the *Post Office Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Post Office (Postage Paid) (Amendment) Regulations, 2011*.

2. The *Post Office (Postage Paid) Regulations, 1998* in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended by deleting regulation 3 and substituting the following:

“3. A person who has a large quantity of postal articles to be transmitted by the Post Office may

- (a) apply in writing to the Postmaster-General for a postage paid permit number, which shall be placed on the indicia of all postal articles transmitted by him through the Post Office; or
- (b) where that service is not intended to be a frequent service request a postage paid service without a permit.”

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 4 and substituting the following:

“4. The Postmaster-General may, upon receipt by him of an application,

- (a) under regulation 3 (a), issue to the applicant a postage paid permit number subject to such conditions as the Postmaster-General approves, and upon the payment by the applicant of the fee of \$400.00; or
- (b) under regulation 3 (b), grant to the applicant the postage paid service without a permit, upon the payment of a fee of \$40.00 for a minimum of 300 items, and there shall be a 3 cent surcharge for each item beyond the minimum of 300 items.”.
