POST OFFICE (OVERSEAS LETTER POST)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2011

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 59 of the *Post Office Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) (Amendment) Regulations, 2011*. S.I. 1980
No. 198.

2. Regulation 7 of the *Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Regulations, 1980*, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, is deleted and the following is substituted:

“Postal articles classified by weight category. Schedule.	“7. No overseas postal article transmitted by letter post is acceptable for transmission unless it is made up in accordance with the weight category set forth in Part I of the <i>Schedule</i> .”;

3. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is amended by

(a) deleting paragraph (1) and substituting the following:

First Schedule.	“9. (1) Subject to these Regulations, the rates of postage in respect of the postal articles transmitted by air mail are those set out in Part II of the <i>First Schedule</i> .”;

(b) deleting paragraph (8) and substituting the following:

Second Schedule.	“(8) The fee to be charged in respect of a reply coupon is the fee specified in paragraph 7 of the <i>Second Schedule</i> .”.

4. Regulation 21 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the words “paragraph 2 of Part I of the Schedule” and substituting “paragraph 1 of the *Second Schedule*”.

5. Regulation 22 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting the following:

“22. (1) The Post Master General may make provision whereby the senders of large volumes of printed matter may enclose such matter in mail bags or bulk post bags supplied by the Post Office and the rate of postage in respect of the printed matter thus transmitted is to be computed in accordance with the rate specified in paragraph 2(iii) of the *Second Schedule*.”.

6. Regulation 23 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (3) and substituting the following:

“(3) There shall be charged in respect of the registration of a postal article, in addition to the ordinary postage payable in respect of that postal article, the fee specified in paragraph 2 of the *Second Schedule*.”.

7. Regulation 24 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting the following:

“24. (1) The sender of a registered postal article is, upon payment by him at the time of registration of the fee specified in paragraph 3 of the *Second Schedule*, entitled to advice of delivery of that article.”.

8. Regulation 27 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (3) and substituting the following:

“(3) Any postal article to which paragraph (1) relates must be forwarded to the addressee, or as the case may be, tendered to the sender and charged with the registration fee specified in paragraph 2 of the *Second Schedule*.”.

9. Regulation 30 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following:

“(2) The charge payable for the insurance of a letter or postal article is to be calculated at the rate specified in paragraph 5 of the *Second Schedule*, and this charge is additional to the normal postage payable for the postage of the letter or postal article.”.

10. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 34 and substituting the following:

11. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by

- (a) renumbering that Schedule as the First Schedule;
 - (b) deleting Part I of the First Schedule as designated by paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the *First Schedule* to these Regulations.

12. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting immediately after the First Schedule the Second Schedule as set out in the *Schedule* to these Regulations.
