DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2011.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, May 8, 2011

- (a) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Philip the section of road known as Three Houses, proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Three Houses road, continuing in a south easterly direction on Mapps road, proceeding in a south westerly direction on the said Mapps road, continuing in a westerly direction on Fairfield road, proceeding in a northerly direction on Bushy Park road, continuing in a westerly direction on Harrow road and finishing at the junction with Sunbury road.
- (b) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Cliff road, commencing at the junction of Featherbed Lane and Kendal, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Cliff road, continuing in a westerly direction on Guinea road, proceeding in a north easterly direction on Ashford road and finishing at the junction of Ashford and Colleton roads.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
