**TRAFFIC CONTROL (COHOBBLOPOT)**  
**RULES, 2011**

The Commissioner of Police, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Cohobblopot) Rules, 2011*.

2. In these Rules,

"emergency vehicle" means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Department of Emergency Management; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

"relevant period" means from 16:00 hours on Sunday, 31st July to 02:30 hours on Monday, 1st August, 2011;

"vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*. Cap. 295.

3. During the relevant period, Kensington New Road to its junction with Fontabelle Road to its junction with Holborn Circle in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Family, Culture, Sports and Youth.

4. During the relevant period, President Kennedy Drive from its junction with Westbury Road to its junction with Holborn Circle, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Family, Culture, Sports and Youth.

5. During the relevant period, no driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall park along Princess Alice Highway from its junction with Cowell Street to its junction with Harbour Road in the parish of Saint Michael.

6. During the relevant period, no driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall park or allow the vehicle to remain stationary on any of the following roads or the adjoining footpaths except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers:

- (a) Fontabelle Road from its junction with Lakes Folly to its junction with President Kennedy Drive;
- (b) Westbury Road from its junction with President Kennedy Drive to its junction with Baxters Road;
- (c) President Kennedy Drive;
- (d) Redman Drive;
- (e) Prescod Boulevard;
- (f) Baxters Road;
- (g) Eagle Hall Road;
- (h) Spring Garden Highway; and
- (i) Kensington New Road,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

7. During the relevant period, Fontabelle Road shall be a one-way street from its junction with Redman Drive to its junction with Holborn Circle in the parish of Saint Michael, and traffic shall flow in two lanes towards Holborn Circle.

8. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified, in paragraphs 4, 6 and 7 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

9. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

10. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or to any emergency vehicle.
