CHAPTER 68

DEMONETISATION

An Act to provide that United Kingdom coins and the half-cent coin 1967-52. issued by the British Caribbean Currency Board shall not be legal tender as from days to be appointed by the Minister responsible for Finance.

[4th September, 1967, Part I; Commence-19th September, 1968, Part II]

1. This Act may be cited as the Demonetisation Act.

Short title.

2. For the purposes of this Act, the expression—

Interpretation.

- "appointed day" means such day as the Minister responsible for Finance, after consultation with the East Caribbean Currency Authority, may appoint by order in relation to Part I and Part II, as the case may be;1
- "British Caribbean Currency Board" means the Board of Commissioners of Currency, British Caribbean Territories (Eastern Group) reconstituted under the British Caribbean Currency Agreement, 1964, as set out in the First Schedule Cap. 65. to the Currency Act;

"East Caribbean Currency Authority" means the Authority established in accordance with the terms of the East Caribbean Currency Agreement, 1965, as set out in the Second Schedule to the Currency Act;
