CHAPTER 301

PRINTERS AND PUBLISHERS

An Act to provide for the printing of the names of printers on papers 1937-10. and books.

[24th September, 1937] Commence-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Printers and Publishers Short title. Act.
- 2. Any person who prints any paper, pamphlet, tract or Name and book whatsoever, which is meant to be published or dispersed, printer to be and who does not print upon the front of every such paper, printed on pamphlet or tract, if the same is printed on one side only, papers and books inor upon the first or last leaf of every paper, pamphlet, tract tended for or book which consists of more than one leaf, in legible publication. characters, his name and usual place of abode or business, shall for every copy of such paper, pamphlet, tract or book be liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-four dollars.

3. Any person who publishes or disperses or assists in pub- Penalty for lishing or dispersing any printed paper, pamphlet, tract or publishing or distributing book on which the name and place of abode or business of the papers withperson printing the same is not printed in accordance with out printer's name. section 2 shall for every copy of such paper, pamphlet, tract or book be liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-four dollars.

4. Sections 2 and 3 shall not extend to the impression of Saving. any engraving or to the printing of the name or the name and address or business or profession of any person and the articles in which he deals, or to any papers, for the sales of estates or goods by auction or otherwise.
