CHAPTER 211

STATUTE OF FRAUDS

An Act for prevention of frauds and perjuries.

1762-1.1965-35.

[16th February, 1762]

Commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Statute of Frauds.

Short title.

2. No action shall be brought whereby to charge the No action defendant upon any special promise to answer for the debt, on certain contracts default or miscarriages of another person, or upon any contract unless or sale of lands, tenements or hereditaments or any interest reduced to writing. in or concerning them, unless the agreement upon which such action is brought, or some memorandum or note thereof, is in writing and signed by the party to be charged therewith or some other person thereunto by him lawfully authorised.
